Dear Mr. Mc Adams,

This letter is in response to the three emails I have received from you this week.

First, let's address the camera issue. The camera on the perimeter road facing south was set in this location so that security can monitor that side of the road and buildings. I assure you the camera was not placed there to harass you.

Secondly, you emailed me your concerns regarding the maintenance staff driving towards you in their golf carts, driving raucously with the golf lights off. I verified the cameras on the date in question and observed the staff be driving cautiously but with the golf lights off. We have addressed the staff and discussed the safety concerns of driving with the lights off. Driving with the headlights off was to avoid shining the lights in the resident's apartment and it was not meant to harass you.

It is clear from your emails that you feel the staff is harassing you and you are unhappy as to what is happening on the campus. You wrote that DSS is not responding to your complaints and that you are considering filing a federal complaint against our staff. The staff has tried to accommodate all your request including setting a table outside your apartment so you can avoid face-to-face time with staff during mealtimes. However, you do not seem satisfied and find other complaints such as having the gardeners "beat-up old truck on the campus" park on campus.

It has been brought to my attention that you were observed walking on campus on Friday January 1, 2021 wearing your mask around your neck. You were also observed on January 3rd again walking on campus with out properly wearing your mask.

Per the discussions from our last campus update meeting, this is your finale warning. If you refuse to follow the CDC and the LACDPH guidelines, the Masonic Homes will have no choice except to relocate you off the campus.

This is a difficult time for all of us, during this COVID-19 pandemic. We have received a Health Care Order from LACDPH on guidelines to help prevent the spread of COVID-19. It is imperative that everyone follow the guidelines.
